

CODE OF PRACTICE

For all persons using Everett's Coppice

FIRES

- DO** put out all fires before leaving the site.
 - DO** ensure you take enough water to put out your fires.
 - DO** take a shovel/spade with you to aid in clearing up.
 - DO** ensure only *small* backwoods fires are made.
 - DO** put the ashes from backwoods fires into the main campfire fire area before leaving.
 - DO NOT** dig fire pits.
 - DO NOT** leave foil in the fire area, it's litter take it home.
 - DO NOT** use soil to put out fires only water.

WOOD

- DO** ensure *only* kindling is taken in to the coppice for burning.
 - DO** use the cut wood and brush available as designated (firewood or gadget wood).

TREES

- DO NOT** use axes and knives on live trees.
 - DO NOT** use live trees as part of a bivouac (live trees can be used as upright support).

RISK ASSESSMENT

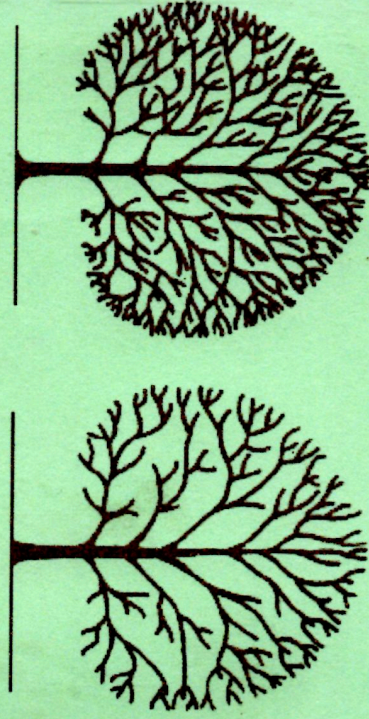
- DO** ensure that a risk assessment has been completed by the Leader for the activity undertaken in the coppice.

GENERAL

- DO** take your litter home.
- DO** respect the wild flora and fauna.
- DO** remember this site is an SSSI.
